Seating and Mobility Clinic

Seating and mobility evaluations include an assessment of posture, strength, range of motion, skin and mobility as it pertains to the use of wheelchairs and other medical equipment. This information is used in the assessment of appropriate positioning and mobility devices.



Pressure mapping measures interface pressures with different cushions, back rests or mattresses. It provides information on interface pressures with different cushions or backs (valuable for the client with skin breakdown).

- Evaluation of function, muscle tone, range of motion, skin breakdown risk and positioning
